- 1. The breath test rendings produced by the Alcotest 7110 MK III may be introduced into evidence in a prosecution for violation of N.J.S.A. 39:4-50 or N.J.S.A. 39:3-10.3 or N.J.S.A. 12:7-46 without the need for the State to produce expert testimony in each case.
- 2. No person who delivers a breath sample of at least .5 liters on the Alcotest 7110 MK III may be charged with refusal pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-50.2 and/or N.J.S.A. 39:4-50-4(a).
- The pending cases of each defendant named in the above caption are remanded back to the Pennsauken Township Municipal Court for a disposition to take place within 45 days of the Order.
